

SSAC Vascular Plant Priority List
(April 12, 2011)

The vascular plant species listed below are those considered to be most in need of the completion of SSAC species status reports. On the Island of Newfoundland, all are known to occur at only one recent general locality, all are extremely rare, and all are particularly vulnerable. Three of the species [*] also occur sparingly in Labrador.

<i>Botrychium ascendens</i>	Ascending Moonwort
<i>Botrychium lanceolatum</i> subsp. <i>lanceolatum</i> *	Lanceleaf Grapefern
<i>Carex radiata</i>	Eastern Starsedge
<i>Cuscuta gronovii</i>	Common Dodder
<i>Cystopteris montana</i> *	Mountain Bladderfern
<i>Dryopteris marginalis</i>	Marginal Woodfern
<i>Eleocharis erythropoda</i>	Bald Spikerush
<i>Goodyera oblongifolia</i>	Menzie's Rattlesnake Plantain
<i>Humulus lupulus</i> var. <i>lupuloides</i>	Hops (native variety)
<i>Listera borealis</i> *	Northern Twayblade
<i>Potamogeton strictifolius</i>	Narrowleaf Pondweed
